MJ2KB TRAIL CLUB'S ADOPT A SECTION OF RAIL TRAIL

THANK YOU FOR PARTICIPATING. THESE ARE GUIDELINES FOR ADOPTING A SECTON OF THE KNOX & KANE RAIL TRAIL FROM THE KINZUA BRIDGE STATE PARK TO US ROUTE 219 (LANTZ CORNERS):

- 1) You or your organization must be members of the MJ2KB Trail Club (to be covered under our liability insurance). Please check your section of trail every month, if you can.
- 2) You are encouraged to do general or "light" maintenance, which may involve any or all of the following:
 - a) Picking up trash
 - b) Removing weeds (either by hand or weed eater). Notify a board member if you intend on spraying herbicides, we have to post the trail if we do.
 - c) Removing branches, sticks or debris from the trail surface
 - d) Trimming branches or brush that could obstruct use of the trail (see diagram), only if you are able, do not use a chain saw unless you notify a board member.
- 3) In the Fall please remove all small branches & sticks from trail surface & the edges (this makes it easier for our leaf vacuum to pick up the dried leaves on the trail).
- 4) You may plant non-invasive plants or flowers along the trail edges (ask before planting trees or large shrubs near the trail). Keep back 3' from trail edge.
- 5) Use your own tools/equipment if you can (or contact a Board Member to obtain equipment from storage container) don't use chain saws alone or without approval of a Board Member. (Jack: 778-5039; Ken: 778-5170; Ron: 598-6785 or Matt: 598-3085)
- 6) Contact a Board Member if trees or large limbs are down; or major repairs to the trail are needed (ie, flooding, washouts, vandalism)
